Extra-Curricular Clubs

Below is information regarding the clubs being offered in the Autumn Term. If your child would like to attend any of the clubs, please complete the attached form and return it to school by <u>Tuesday 24 September</u> along with any money if relevant. Any forms returned after this date will not be processed.

Again, the clubs are being offered on a termly rota starting in the week beginning **Monday 30 September** and will run for **8 weeks** (three weeks of clubs before half term and five weeks after). All school staff-run clubs and Art and Craft Club will finish at 4:15pm. Clubs run by other outside agencies will finish at 4:30pm.

Please note that there will be <u>no clubs</u> running on the final week of the first half-term, wb Monday 21 October, due to Parents Evenings and all clubs will end by Friday 6 December.

You will be informed of the clubs to which your child has been allocated (as there are limitations of numbers to some clubs), along with details of where to collect them from. If permission is given on the return form, children in Years 5 and 6 will be able to walk home without being collected by an adult.

Please remember that, if children join a club, they are expected to attend each week unless the school office is notified by a parent or carer. We do prefer that, if children sign up for a club, they remain committed to attending on a weekly basis. In addition, some clubs can only go ahead if there are enough children signed up for it.

Additional Information

Multi-Sports, led by Mr Blackham, offers an exciting opportunity for children to experience a range of different challenges and have fun whilst developing key skills. This is a fantastic opportunity for those in Key Stage 1.

All football clubs will be outdoors so, for their safety, it is essential that children have appropriate football boots, shin pads and outdoor clothing.

Netball Club will run indoors when the weather is not conducive to playing outside.

Indoor Sports will focus on various games that teach the skills of attacking and defending. The children will also refine their skills for passing, catching, throwing and hand/eye coordination.

Reading club will offer a quiet space for children to read and share their favourite books. There will also be an opportunity to hear an adult read a group story (chosen by the children in week 1) during each session.

Finally, as well as the clubs attached, there are lunchtime activities on offer, including eCadets (invitation only), Recorders, Ukulele and Prayer Club. Permission is not required for these and pupils can just turn up.

As before, we are pleased to be able to continue to offer children who are entitled to Pupil Premium funding a space at one paying club run by the external providers again this term. There will be no charge for attending the club selected for this term.

We hope that your children find a club that they would like to join. Again, the successful running of our clubs depends on your support.
