Reception Spring Term Expectations for Literacy and Mathematics

By the end of the Spring Term (Easter) all children should be able to achieve the following statements:

Maths



- I can count up to 20 objects with 1:1 correspondence.
- I can order numbers 0-20.
- I can find the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them.
- I can find one more or one less from a group of up to five objects, then ten objects.

Reading



- I can recognise and read most Phase 3 sounds in words, (j,v,w,x,z,zz,qu,ch,sh,ng,th,ai,ee,igh,oa,oo,ar,or,ur,ow,oi,ear,air,ure,er)
- I can read most phase 3 tricky words, (he,she,we,me,be,was,my,you,all,are,they).
- I can read and understand a caption or simple sentence.

Writing



- I can segment to spell most Phase 3 sounds in words (j,v,w,x,z,zz,qu,ch,sh,ng,th,ai,ee,igh,oa,oo,ar,or,ur,ow,oi,ear,air,ure,er)
- I can write a caption or short sentence in a meaningful context.
- I can form cursive letters correctly, sitting them on the line.
