Reception Summer Term Expectations for Literacy and Mathematics

By the end of the Summer Term all children should be able to achieve the following statements:

Maths



I can say which number is one more or one less than a given number to 20.

I can add and subtract two single digit numbers by counting on and counting back to find the answer.

I can solve problems including doubling, halving and sharing.

Reading



I can read simple sentences and talk about what I have read.

I can read most phase 4 tricky words (said, so, have, like, some, come, you, were, there, little, one, do, what, out, when).

Writing



I can write all phase 3 tricky words and some phase 4 tricky words.

I can write simple sentences on my own, which can be read by myself and others.

I begin my sentences with a captain capital letter, leave spooky spaces between my words and finish my sentences with a Freddy full stop.
