

## Autumn Term Week 8



The children have shown a real interest in pirates this week. During the week we have built a giant pirate ship outside with the wooden blocks, designed our own pirate maps and enjoyed playing with the small world pirate ships in water. We linked this with letters and sounds and had the sounds floating in the water to see which ones we recognised. The children very much enjoyed being outside in our woodland area this week so we will be introducing Welly Wednesdays to take our learning outside (please see below for more information). Next week the children have asked if we can continue with the pirate theme. We will continue to listen for the sounds we have learnt in different words e. g 'o' for octopus, and accurately count 3 or 4 objects. This will be achieved and observed through play based activities that the children have shown interest in and chosen to take part in themselves.
