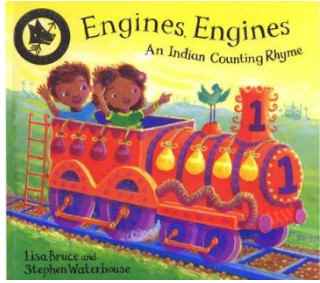


Autumn Term Week 9



What a busy first half term we have had! The children have faced lots of changes this half term and we are so proud of how well they are adapting and settling into Reception. This week the children have been extremely busy. They enjoyed their autumn ramble and used some fantastic autumnal vocabulary to describe what they can see.

During the first week back we will be learning all about India through the story 'Engines Engines'. This is in preparation for the following week where we will be learning all about Diwali. We will learn facts about India, labelling some pictures of Indian landmarks and food. We will also be building or writing CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words e.g. 'run' on the wheels of trains. In Maths we will be identifying the numbers on the engines from the story and dabbing the corresponding amount of dots onto the engines. We will also be solving problems such as, 'There are 5 engines and 4 people, what shall we do?'
