Reception Autumn Term Expectations for Literacy and Mathematics

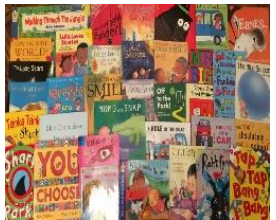
By the end of the Autumn Term (Christmas) all children should be able to achieve the following statements:

Maths



- I can count from 0 to 15.
- I can count up to 15 objects with 1:1 correspondence.
- I can recognise numerals 0 to 10.
- I understand that numbers must be in order.

Reading



- I can read all Phase 2 sounds (s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k,ck,h,l,ll,r,f,e,u,b,ss,ff).
- I can read all phase 2 tricky words. (I,no,go,to,the,into, and).
- I can read simple words by sounding out each letter and blending them together.

Writing



- I can write my first name, correctly formed with a capital letter.
- I can write all Phase 2 sounds (s,a,t,p,i,n,m,d,g,o,c,k,ck,h,l,ll,r,f,e,u,b,ss,ff).
- I can write simple CVC words on my own (such as cat, dog, pin etc).
- I can name all the letters of the alphabet.
- I can hold a pencil correctly.
