Writing	Instructions
Reading	Reviewing comprehension skills, evaluating texts, vocabulary development- 'The Fire Comes Closer'. Editing and improving responses.
Spelling / Handwriting	<p>Adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words ending in -fer The r is doubled if the -fer is still stressed when the ending is added. The r is not doubled if the -fer is no longer stressed. For example: referring, referred, referral, preferring, preferred, transferring, transferred reference, referee, preference, transference</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Prefixes Before a root word starting with l, in- becomes il. Before a root word starting with r, in- becomes ir-. For example: illegal, illegible irregular, irrelevant, irresponsible</p>
Maths	<p>Daily Practice: Addition/Subtraction/Multiplication/Division; Fractions- adding; Place Value - x and ÷ by 10,100 or 1000; BODMAS and Measures- converting between units. Angles continued... Dragon Masters continued...(using algebra/thinking strategically)</p>
