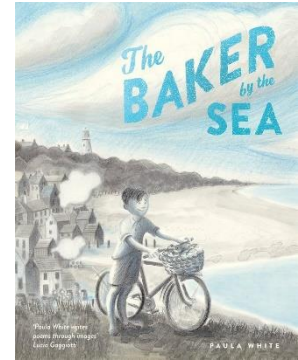


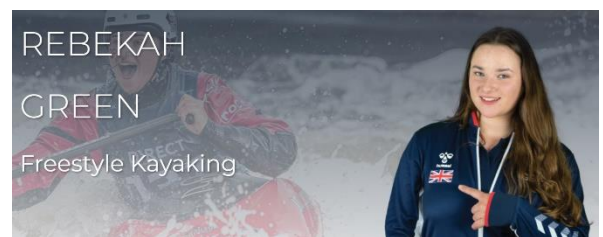
Year 2 Newsletter - 24.05.24
